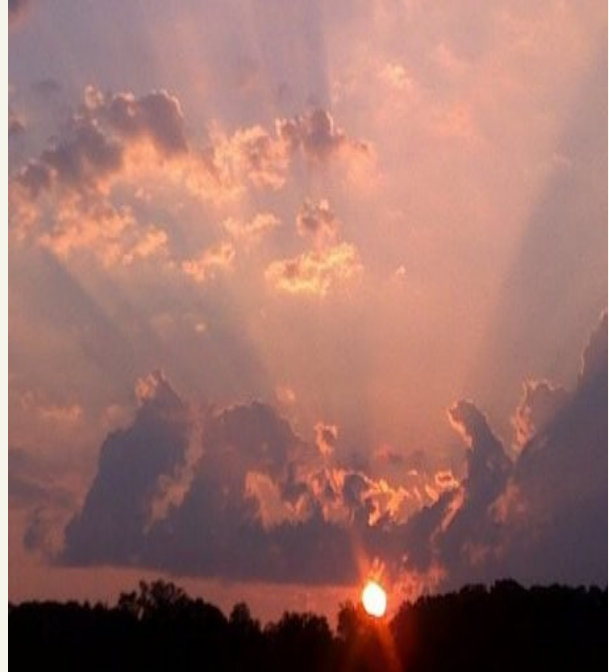
event so lets all get out and show our support for our new museum.
